Just a brief update from City Staff regarding construction along Summit Avenue:

- Landscaping has begun in the median. The plan was designed by local landscape architect, Randal Romie.

- Completion of paving, including lane striping, is scheduled to be completed by November 18th.
- Drivers will encounter partial lane closures around the work areas.
- All construction schedules will be dependent on the weather.
